Skip Hollandsworth grew up in Wichita Falls, Texas and attended TCU in Fort Worth. Since 1989, he has been a staff writer at Texas Monthly magazine, where he has received several journalism awards. He has been a finalist four times for a National Magazine Award, the magazine industry's equivalent of the Pulitzer Prize, and in 2010 he won the National Magazine Award in feature writing for "Still Life," his story about a young man who, after suffering a crippling football injury in high school, spent the next 33 years in his bedroom, unable to move. The 2012 movie "Bernie", which he co-wrote with Richard Linklater, is based on another of his stories, "Midnight in the Garden of East Texas," published in Texas Monthly in 1998.
